Altea is located right on the sea in the middle of a beautiful bay and is surrounded by hilly mountains. The name comes from the Moorish 'Althaya' which means 'health for all'.

Benidoleig is located in the Girona Valley of the Marina Alta area in Spain's Costa Blanca. Among the various amenities within the village is a junior/infant school, nursery school (local authority run), medical centre, post office, supermarket, tobacconist/newsagents, hardware store, curtain shop, hairdresser, estate agent/sign

shop, printers, bank, pharmacy and various Spanish bars. The village is also well catered with a Spanish restaurant (La Lloma) and an International restaurant (El Cid Restaurant & Bar). The scenery of the area includes cliff tops, rocky coves, sandy beaches and tiny bays along the Benissa Costa. The



Calpe



Calpe is a town on Spain's Mediterranean coast. It's known for its beaches, like sandy Arenal-Bol. Nearby is the Roman site Baños de la Reina, with rock-cut sea pools. On a headland to the east, Peñón de Ifach is a huge limestone rock with thriving birdlife. Below it lie the ruins of Pobla de Ifac, a medieval walled village. La Muralla Roja is an

iconic castle-like building by modern Spanish architect Ricardo Bofill. The beaches in Calpe are not like other beaches on the Costa Blanca coast! The Mountain Rock Penon de Ifach is the epitome of magical powers that unfolded here many centuries ago. The Mountain cliff on the beach of Calpe, has the same size and formation gorge in the mountain behind La Nucia and Alfaz del Pi. There are many stories, legends and sagas about how this mountain cliff has ended up on the shoreline in Calpe.

and Christian civilizations. As of 2014, it had a population of 41,672, although this is more than doubled by tourism during the summer months. Denia enjoys almost twenty kilometres of coastline. To the north of the town, there are beaches of fine sand and shallow waters, such as Les Marines, LAlmadrava, Les Deveses, Les Bovetes and els Palmars, To the south lie a series of small coves along the rocky coast, known as Les Rotes, which is a paradise for fishermen and divers.

El Vergel

recently resuscitated, pays homage to its name: it displays two trees and four flowers. The municipal boundaries confront those of Beniarbeig, Benimeli, Murla, Dénia, Ondara and Els Poblets. The town is 91 km from both Alicante and Valencia, and constitutes part of the frontier between the Province of Alicante and that of Valencia.

Gata de Gorgos

The town's key fiestas take place during July to honour The Christ of the Calvary. (Fiestas en honor al Santísimo Cristo del Calvario). A key part of this event includes bull running along the street known as Paseo de Alicante – another is when the town's young men and women who are 'coming of age' form groups called 'Quintos' and march through the town accompanied by music and watched by family and friends.

promontory overlooking the Mediterranean Sea, 51 km north of Alicante and 8 km north of Benidorm. The municipality includes the following urbanization: Barranco Hondo, Coloma, Bello Horizonte, Panorama, and El Tossal.

Moraira is a small, upmarket Spanish coastal town, part of Teulada (also known as Teulada-Moraira) municipality, in the Marina Alta comarca, 80 km north of Alicante and 100 km south of Valencia. The town is located adjacent to the neighbouring village of El Portet and both communities form a tourist resort on the Costa Blanca strip, with

8 km of coastline backed by mountains and vineyards.

Moraira is a small and very nice town with natural beaches, coves, rocky and sandy beaches; an old fishing village that has developed in the recent years, especially in the summer months as a popular touristic destination, but preserving its originality. The castle on the beach is the emblem of the city.

Orba is a small town and municipality in the comarca of Marina Alta in the Valencian Community, Spain. It is situated in the River Gerona valley and is bordered by Pego to the north; Benidoleig and Ondara to the northeast; Jalón and Pedreguer to the east and Parcent and Alcalali to the south. Orba is a

Writer Gabriel Miró (1879-1930) was a resident of Parcent and called it a "paradise between the mountains". It is also close to Jalón (written as Xaló in Catalan), which is known for its wine production and markets. The traditional economy of Parcent relies on almond and orange farming in the surrounding area.

#1 The name Costa Blanca was dreamed up by British European Airways as a promotional gimmick to promote its flights between London and Valencia in the 1950s. Costa Blanca means white coast. The promotion paid off as the area is still known as the Costa Blanca.

#2 The Costa Blanca has one of the healthiest climates in Europe, says the World Health Organisation. Its warm temperatures throughout the year, clean air and low rainfall make it a great place to live. The climate is particularly good for people with arthritis or asthma.

#3 Benidorm was the first package holiday resort in Spain. The town's popularity increased when he allowed women to wear bikinis on the beach. In Europe only London and Milan have more skyscrapers than Benidorm. The Gran Hotel Bali, Benidorm., is the tallest hotel in Spain standing at 186 metres high.

Pedreguer




Pedreguer is a town in the comarca of
Marina Alta in the province of Alicante, Spain.
The town is situated at the foot of the
Muntanya Gran and close to the two larger
coastal towns of Dénia and Xàbia. It has a
population of 7097 (as of 2008). It is also
close to the Jalon Valley which is famous for

its springtime almond tree blossom. While Pedreguer does not have any world famous sights nor is it on the coast, it is a pretty and scenic base from which to enjoy a great holiday on the Costa Blanca with many great tourist attractions nearby.

Pedreguer Rastro is a sort of flea market in the town. Sunday morning is flea market day. Held on the polygons where people flock from all over the Costa Blanca to buy and sell produce, clothing, gifts, home made jams, chutneys and much more.

Polop de la Marina or briefly Polop, is a municipality in the comarca of Marina Baixa, Alicante, Valencian Community, Spain. The village of Polop is located inland in the Costa Blanca North in an area known as the Marina Alta. The local economy is based mainly on agriculture, so much of the surrounding

countryside is covered in polythene to act as giant greenhouses.

The village is a delight to explore and perfect for a morning or afternoon amble. The hill, where the old castle used to be is encircled by a medieval wall, and is a 'must' to walk up. Follow the zig zag path and you'll be well rewarded with some fabulous views. On a clear day you can see right to Albir and Altea on the coast and inland to Callosa and the Sierra Bernia.
